The GSF Going for Gold QI programme can help you improve end of life care in your practice using the well-evidenced GSF tools, resources and step-by-step processes successfully used for over a decade by hundreds of UK practices. If wanted, practice teams can progress to GSF Accreditation co-badged by RCGP in recognition of their quality of care. Rooted in primary care and developed by primary care clinicians, GSF Going for Gold helps answer the questions of HOW to improve care, in simple practical steps, ensuring the whole practice team are engaged and involved.

The Going for Gold programme:

The Practice-based distance learning QI training programme comes via access to the members area of the GSF website. The training is for the whole practice team to be delivered at regular team meetings. It includes everything you need to ensure interactive productive sessions that help you progress to real change in your practice. The 6 modules each include 3 Learning outcomes, action plans and reflections covering;

1. Awareness - why we need to improve end of life care and baseline ADA audit
2. Identifying patients early and provide more proactive care using needs-based coding
3. How to initiate Advance Care Planning discussions
4. How to enable patients and carers to live well
5. How to enable patients to die well
6. Supporting families in bereavement, repeat ADA audit and practice protocol

The Accreditation Process

There are 4 parts to the process:

- Part 1: Key outcome ratios - evidence of attainment of standards in key areas over the last year & Patient Audit - After Death Analysis x 5 deaths to demonstrate GSF is embedded in practice and a reflective audit of patients not on the register.
- Part 2: Portfolio of evidence - statement of how you attain the 7 key tasks with supporting evidence and an action plan for sustainability.
- Part 3: Assessment Visit - Visit from The GSF Assessment team to assess implementation, team awareness and long-term sustainability.
- Part 4: Attendance at the GSF conference to celebrate your success and receive your Quality Hallmark Award.
